

GUIDELINES FOR SUBMITTING AND PARTICIPATING to the Conference

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1. BEFORE SUBMITTING your abstract(s)/paper(s)

- The deadline for submissions is April 4, 2021 (check the <u>dates and deadlines</u> of the Conference).
- You can choose between two submission formats: ABSTRACT and PAPER.
 - Each author can submit up to two contributions, in different panels.
 - o <u>PAPERS must include an abstract</u> of maximum 500 words (see instructions on p. 5).
- Each accepted ABSTRACT/PAPER must be backed by a <u>APP FEE</u> (the Conference formula is 1 ABSTRACT/PAPER → 1 APP FEE). Learn more on the <u>FEES</u> webpage.
- ABSTRACTS/PAPERS can be submitted through the <u>pre-conference tool</u> only. Convenors will automatically receive the submitted ABSTRACTS/PAPERS via the pre-conference tool (please do not send them by email). Once you have completed the submission process, you will no longer be able to edit/upload the ABSTRACTS/PAPERS you have submitted.
 - <u>Before submitting</u> on the pre-conference tool, please:
 - identify a Panel where to submit your ABSTRACT/PAPER (view full list)
 - draft the text of your ABSTRACT/PAPER offline (please highlight methods, results, bibliography; word count includes references). Only later, during the submission process on the pre-conference tool, paste the abstract text and, in the case of the PAPER, upload the paper file (see the instructions on p. 5).
 - In the case of <u>coauthored ABSTRACTS/PAPERS</u>, the author submitting the ABSTRACT/PAPER (X) needs to register as the <u>Corresponding author</u>, i.e., the <u>First author</u> of the ABSTRACT/PAPER (X). We recommend that you indicate as <u>First Author</u> and provide the details of the person who actually pays for the <u>APP FEE*</u> and presents the ABSTRACT/PAPER in the chosen Panel session. At the time of submission and presentation of the ABSTRACT/PAPER (X), the person who registered at the Conference with the FEE APP will be the <u>First Author</u>.

These rules will also be applied to the other <u>Coauthors</u> who will submit ABSTRACTS/PAPERS (Y) on their own as <u>First Authors</u> in the same panel or in others. <u>Co-authors</u> who do not submit any ABSTRACT/PAPER as <u>First</u>



<u>author</u> may access to the Conference via the <u>discounted P FEE</u> (check the <u>FEES</u> webpage)*.

- Accepted submissions will be published in the Conference Books.
 - <u>All the abstracts</u> (both those submitted as ABSTRACTs and those included in a PAPER) <u>will be published</u> before the Conference in Open Access in the Conference *Book of Abstracts* (see the <u>Book of Abstract</u> published at the first Conference of Scuola Democratica).

All those who submit an ABSTRACT will have the opportunity to turn their ABSTRACT into a PAPER that will be published after the conference in the Conference *Proceedings Book*.

- <u>PAPERS will be published</u> after the Conference in Open Access in the ISBNsupplied Conference Proceedings Book (see the <u>Books of Proceedings</u> published at first Conference of Scuola Democratica). Abstracts of the PAPERS will be published before the conference in the *Book of Abstracts*.
- **English** is the language for the ABSTRACTS/PAPERS and for the presentations (PDF/PPT/oral) in the <u>Panels</u>.
- ABSTRACTS/PAPERS must include:
 - 1. <u>A title</u>, limited to 20 words, in UPPER CASE
 - 2. Full name, institution, and email address of all authors
 - 3. From 3 to 5 keywords
 - 4. <u>The text of the ABSTRACT</u> (maximum 500 words).
 - 5. (5). In case you opt for the PAPER, <u>the text of the paper</u> must be between 3,500 and 5,000 words. An abstract of maximum 500 words must be included.
- **Notifications of abstract acceptance** will be sent automatically to the email address provided by the first author on the pre-conference tool.
- For each ABSTRACT/PAPER, a **presentation of no more than 20 minutes** is expected.

^{*} For the admission of co-authored Abstracts/Papers, it is not required all authors to pay a FEE: first author's APP FEE covers the Abstract/Paper admission. Second, third, fourth author (and so on) register with the P FEE only if they wish to access the Conference.



2. SUBMITTING your abstract(s)/paper(s)

YOUR PERSONAL ACCOUNT

A free personal account to access the **<u>pre-conference tool</u>** is required for ABSTRACT/PAPER submission.

- 1. Go to the <u>access page</u> and select the language by clicking on **English** at the top of the page.
- 2. Generate your own account (your profile). Click on the blue link "**Create an** account and submit a contribution".



3. On the new page, enter the required data.

Warning: If you are creating the account on behalf of someone else, enter the details of this other person. The data entered must be those who will effectively attend the conference.

4. After entering the data, on the bottom of the page click on the button "**Create User Account only, Submit Contribution Later**".

- 6. When you will be back to the <u>access page</u>, just enter your e-mail or username and your password to log in.

SUBMISSION PROCESS

We recommend drafting and completing the ABSTRACT/PAPER offline and copying&pasting it to fill the form on the submission tool.

- 1. Log into the <u>access page</u> and click on "Your submissions".
- 2. Read carefully the instructions and links on the page. Then, click on **"Submit your abstract**" or on **"Submit your paper**". A new page will open.
- In the "About the author/s" section, enter authors' information. (<u>Bear in mind</u>: the first author, the corresponding author, the presenting author and the one who backs the APP FEE are the same person).
 - Go to the Author/s row.
 - Enter only Name, Surname, E-mail for each author: the **first author** (i.e., **corresponding author**, **presenting author** and **APP FEE** author) in the first row.
 - The org. number column works as an index. If the contribution has multiple authors from different organisations, enter an index number each author's organisation. This index number must correspond to the line number of the organisations listed as affiliation in the organisation row.

- 4. In the section **Contribution Details**, please enter the details of your contribution.
 - enter the title of your ABSTRACT/PAPER (max. 20 words in UPPERCASE).
 - enter the abstract of your ABSTRACT/PAPER (a text of up to 500 words, which may be formatted using italics and lists).



- If you choose to submit a **PAPER**, you will be asked to upload a DOC/DOCX file of maximum 8 megabytes via the **upload** button in the **next page**. In this case, you have first to select the **panel** that best suits your submission and then proceed to the **next page** where the **upload** procedure is available.



5. Select one **panel** from the list that best suits your submission.



- 6. Enter at least 3 and up to 5 **keywords** for your contribution, separated by commas. Finally, you must confirm that your submission complies with the Conference's submission guidelines. Then click on "**Proceed**".
- 7. Now, on the next page, carefully check the correctness of the displayed data. Please check your entries before submitting your contribution. Note that you have to click on "**Complete Submission**" to confirm, finalize and save your contribution.
- Please remember that you will not be able to edit your contribution after you submit it. If there are any corrections to make, click on "Return to Step 1". Otherwise, click on "Yes, send my contribution" and then on the button "Complete Submission ".
- 9. Once you have submitted your ABSTRACT/PAPER you will receive a confirmation by email.



3. AFTER THE SUBMISSION: REGISTRATION AND PARTICIPATION IN THE CONFERENCE (FEES)

From April the 19th, 2021, the acceptance of ABSTRACT/PAPER will be notified to the First Author.

Once you received the notification of acceptance of your ABSTRACT/PAPER, you can proceed with the **registration** to the Conference and the APP FEE payment.

Registration is on the <u>pre-conference tool</u>. Before starting the procedure, you need to have already executed the wire bank transfer for the **APP FEE** (check **EARLY BIRD** deadline on the <u>FEES</u> webpage)

Reason of the transfer: **identification code** of the ABSTRACT/PAPER accepted, **First Name, Last Name** and **SD2 Conference**, as in the following example:

Once you made the wire bank transfer, save and store the **digital receipt of the transfer**.

REGISTRATION VIA PRE-CONFERENCE TOOL

Once the transfer has been made, you can proceed to the **registration** on the **pre-conference tool**.

The procedure involves 1) uploading the receipt of the transfer and 2) confirming the personal data already present in the system.

Once the registration is completed, you will receive a summary and confirmation e-mail. Enclosed to the confirmation email, you will find a **pro-forma receipt** of your wire bank transfer. <u>This receipt is not an electronic invoice</u>. The **electronic invoice** will be sent in separately and later on.

- In case an organization (Department, University, Research Centre, Association) has executed the **APP FEE wire bank transfer** for you, you can request the **electronic invoice** for the organization you belong to by sending an e-mail to



the following address: <u>segreteria@scuolademocratica.it</u> (you will provide the required information regarding the organization). This procedure also applies in the case the **APP FEE wire bank transfer** has been executed by the **First Author**, but the latter requires that the **electronic invoice** be sent the organization s/he belongs to in order to get refunded.

- In case that the **APP FEE transfer is made by a person other than the person who will actually present**, it will be possible to send a request to the following email: <u>segreteria@scuolademocratica.it</u> to obtain the electronic invoice in the name of that person.



1. THE CONFERENCE

Signing up takes less than 1 minute.

Once logged in, you can read the Conference **participation policy code**, download the Conference program and the Book of Abstracts, join Conference chats and forum.

You can also get familiar with **ZOOM** which is the device for all Conference ONLINE activities

You can present and discuss your accepted ABSTRACT/PAPER at the dedicated **ZOOM** Panel.

You can choose to attend and, if you wish, switch from one **<u>ZOOM</u>** Panel to another.

You can attend Keynote speeches, Symposia and Special Session via **ZOOM**

The **LIVE PLATFORM** will be available from a few days before the Conference kick-off.
